

Apply to be a ----PTSA Student Representative

Role and Responsibilities:

Student representatives are expected to attend regularly scheduled PTSA meetings as much as their academic schedules allow. In the event conflicts occur, they should make a reasonable attempt to notify the PTSA president of their expected absence and forward any announcements or report that they have prepared.

A report can consist of:

- Important upcoming events for their particular class.
- Issues or concerns that classmates have with policies or events at the school.
- Significant accomplishments by clubs, sports teams or classmates that they may wish to share.

Students serve on the Board to provide a voice for concerns from students in the class which they represent (and the student body at large). They should be prepared to discuss issues and ask questions of the administrators and PTSA Board members. They can also be a valuable asset by providing a students' perspective on various issues that arise.

We would like student to feel comfortable sharing their concerns and presenting insight into the day to day living around the school. It is also a valuable opportunity to interface with parents and administrators.

Students are reminded that a respectful, responsible attitude is expected and the understanding that it is a privilege to serve.

Criteria for Selection-

1. High school students must be current PTSA members.
2. Middle School students may serve as non-voting members only (following established PTSA age restriction guidelines).
3. Must be a student in good standing.
4. Selection will be made by a committee of PTSA Board members. Students' names will be withheld from the selection committee until selection has been made.
5. Please include your name, phone number, address, email address, year in school (freshman, junior etc.) and a paragraph describing why you would like to serve. Students selected will be notified by phone. Questions, please contact Patti Rothwell @ rothwellb@cox.net.
